Reimbursements During a Continuing Resolution

This apportions reimbursements and other discretionary spending authority from offsetting collections (not otherwise apportioned) for accounts of the Food and Drug Administration, Health Resources and Services Administration, Indian Health Service, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, National Institutes of Health, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, Office of the Secretary, Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response, Administration for Community Living, and Office of the Inspector General for the period of the FY 2023 continuing resolution (CR) and any extensions (including the time period covered by Section 120.41 of OMB Circular A-11). This letter apportionment applies only to Treasury Account Fund Symbols receiving automatic apportionments of funds from the Continuing Resolution.

Reimbursable amounts, including amounts available under Section 241 of the Public Health Service Act, funded from accounts receiving appropriations from the continuing resolution are limited to the pro-rata amounts apportioned by OMB for the period of the continuing resolution.

All footnotes and conditions specified in the most recent prior apportionment remain in effect.
