Pursuant to OMB apportionment authority under 31 U.S.C. 1512, as delegated to me, I hereby reapportion for expenditure from the respective TAFSs listed above those remaining unliquidated amounts that were obligated on contracts in fiscal years 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 in excess of the previously apportioned amounts, solely to liquidate such over-obligations. OMB apportions with the understanding that USDA will report the violations as required by the ADA and will provide OMB a draft of its ADA violation notice within 10 days of this reapportionment.
