CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION TRANSMITTAL LETTER

Consistent with section 7015 of the Department of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2024 (Div. F, P.L. 118-47), (“FY 2024 Act”), as carried forward by the Full-Year Continuing Appropriations and Extensions Act, 2025 (Div. A, P.L. 119-4) (“FY 2025 Act”) and section 34 of the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956, the Department is notifying plans to obligate \$330.1 million in FY 2025 funds from the Contribution for International Peacekeeping Activities (CIPA) account, including a \$75.0 million assessed contribution for the UN Support Office in Haiti.

These changes are reflected in the enclosed updated operating plan, which include a total of \$683,704,000 for the assessed and other expenses of international peacekeeping activities directed to the maintenance or restoration of international peace and security.

Of the \$683.7 million in FY 2025 CIPA funds available for obligation in FY 2026, \$353.6 million will be obligated to pay assessments for the UNIFIL mission (\$139.6 million) and MONUSCO mission (\$214 million) as outlined in the operating plan transmitted on October 10, 2025. An additional \$330.1 million will be allocated to cover partial assessments for other peacekeeping missions, aligned with their mandate expiration dates, as outlined in the attached chart.

This operating plan includes funds for the United Nations Support Office in Haiti (UNSOH), a newly established UN Support Office providing logistics and operational support to the non-UN Gang Suppression Force under UN Security Council Resolution 2793 (2025), effective September 30, 2025. Current estimates for the mission for the period from October 2, 2025, through June 30, 2026, are \$300 million. Based on the United Nations assessed rate of 26.1 percent, the U.S. share is estimated at \$78.3 million, and payable at \$75 million under the 25 percent cap. The UN's annual estimate at full operating capability for UNSOH is \$400 million. Final budget

figures for UNSOH are pending approval by the General Assembly. These figures are based on available data and subject to change. The mission is authorized by UNSCR 2793 for an initial 12-month period to be renewed by the UNSC after 12 months. The Standing Group of Partners identified in the UNSCR will take responsibility for developing metrics and benchmarks for success of the mission and tethering that to a clear exit strategy. The mission's objective is to restore baseline security in Haiti to prevent state collapse. Such a collapse at the hands of violent gangs could unleash a wave of illegal immigration throughout the region, including to the United States, and risks turning Haiti into an exporter of crime and drugs impacting the United States.

Application of Credits

The combined amount of CIPA appropriations and credits applied by the UN would not exceed 25 percent of the total amount of peacekeeping assessments for all UN Member States for each individual peacekeeping mission.

The FY 2024 Actual amount for MINUSMA also includes an additional assessment for MINUSMA - \$74.6 for the period from January 1 through June 30, 2024 at the actual rate of 26.94 percent. The FY 2024 Actual amounts did not include \$7.1 million of non cap-related, payable arrears for the final assessment of MINUSMA from January 1 through June 30, 2025.
