

Breastfeeding Peer Counselors: Apportionment Row 6012

The Full-Year Continuing Appropriations and Extensions Act, 2025 (P.L. 119-4 (139STAT 16) Sec. 1202(3)), based on section 17 (h)(10)(B)(ii) of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1786). The funding supports a key component of the WIC Program by providing comprehensive, up-to-date breastfeeding information and peer counseling.

Please note that Breastfeeding Peer Counselors was provided \$90,000,000 in 25/26 funds. Carryover funds apportioned to this line are \$423,177.
