

Requested Information for ACF apportionments FY 2026
Anti-Trafficking in Persons (Refugee and Entrant Assistance)

- Program/activity objective:
 - The Anti-Trafficking in Persons (ATIP) program implements statutory requirements to assist victims of human trafficking, increase identification and response to human trafficking through public awareness and training, and monitor grant programs and human trafficking victimization trends.
- Planned use and allocation of funds, including all allocations referenced in the agency Operating Plan and statutory set-asides;
 - ACF provides these planned obligations based on a point in time estimate (February 2026):
 - ATIP: \$20.6 million for grants, \$7.4 million for contracts, and \$2.7 million for admin, including \$1.3 million for salaries.
