This program awards grants for acquisition of interests in sites identified in the Civil War Sites Advisory Commission's 1993 Report on the Nation's Civil War Battlefields, as well as sites related to the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812 identified in the NPS's Report to Congress on the Historic Preservation of Revolutionary War and War of 1812 Sites in the United States. NPS will ensure senior leadership has reviewed and approved all NOFOs, and all NOFOs shall be reviewed by the Assistant Secretary for Fish, Wildlife and Parks. NOFOs with an estimated total program funding of \$1M or more shall be reviewed the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary, exercising the authority of the Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget, and the Senior Advisor to the Secretary. Finally, upon DOI clearance, the NPS Budget Officer shall submit all NOFOs with an estimated total program funding of \$2M or more to their OMB Interior Branch Analyst for review/approval.
