ESF	1,534,000	<p>NIMF will replace the 60-year-old Plum Island Animal Disease Center (PIADC) where USDA's Agricultural Research Service (ARS) and Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) currently conduct foreign animal disease research, training and diagnostics. Expanding the mission of PIADC, NIMF is dedicated to the study of diseases that threaten human America's livestock industry and public health. As a next generation laboratory, NIMF is crucial to the protection of our nation's food supply, APHIS's response to public health and safety.
